
- (i) Registered postal code will be displayed for users with a Singapore-registered address. Passport number will be displayed for users with an overseas-registered address.
- (ii) The password PIN mailer may take up to three working days to arrive at a local registered addresses. For overseas registered addresses, delivery time will depend on overseas postal services.


Scammers can create spoof websites that look exactly the same as the real ones to trick unsuspecting victims into disclosing their login details or personal info.





Look out for transactional alerts from Singpass. An SMS or email notification is sent when changes are made to your Singpass account, such as password change or reset.

Keep your contact details registered with Singpass up to date to receive these alerts promptly. If you receive such alerts without initiating any change, you should contact Singpass Helpdesk immediately to secure your account.

What happens if I lose my Singpass credentials?

After obtaining the victim's Singpass login credentials, scammers can...



Take over Singpass account fully by:

Misuse account for fraudulent activities e.g. set up accounts for money laundering



Has someone offered you money in exchange for your Singpass login credentials?
Beware! Your account may be misused for criminal activities. **Never attempt to sell your Singpass account.**You may be accountable if your Singpass account is used for crimes.

Together, we can transact safely!

While there are **technical safeguards** in place, **user vigilance** plays an equally important role in the fight against scams.
